EIPNV Has Evidence Of Election Irregularities **Secretary Of State Aguilar Notified**

"Nevada Needs Elections It Can Trust"

Reno, Nevada - Election Integrity Project® Nevada Delivers Notice To Nevada Secretary Of State: Judy Moss, Executive Council Manager of Election Integrity Project Nevada, delivered a letter of notification of apparent irregularities in the Nevada Primary Election in June 2026. The results of the research are shocking with tens of thousands of irregular voting records in the system.

EIPNV's Research Needs Immediate Attention: *"The Secretary of State should not rely on the approaching National Voter Registration Act deadline as a reason to postpone investigating these findings," Moss said. "Nevadans deserve a complete accounting of these discrepancies before the November General Election, not afterward. If inaccuracies exist in Nevada's voter registration rolls, they should be identified and corrected now so that every eligible voter—and only eligible voters—participates in the November General Election."*

Based Upon Its Review of the Statewide Voter Registration Database: Election Integrity Project® Nevada, believes the discrepancies identified, address changes, unreconciled active registration totals, records lacking a registration status, and the assignment of June 9 Primary Election vote codes to those records, raise serious questions about the integrity of the voter registration rolls used during the June 9 Primary Election.
